CWP LAUNCHES 2011 NATIONAL ORATORY CONTEST

Cable & Wireless Panama (CWP), the Panama business of Cable & Wireless Communications, has launched the National Oratory Contest 2011, one of the country's most popular annual events.

The National Oratory Contest involves more than 10,000 high school students, teachers and parents from across Panama.
