CWC TO LAUNCH LTE IN ANTIGUA & BARBUDA

LIME Antigua & Barbuda, part of Cable & Wireless Communications plans to launch fourth generation Long term Evolution (4G LTE) mobile data services having been awarded radio spectrum.

The new 4G LTE services will improve the mobile data services available to LIME customers. The speeds at which customers will be able to download online services and applications will increase by more than 50 times. LIME customers will be able to surf the web and stream music and video wherever they are, on any compatible mobile device.

The LTE network will support the Government's objective to improve access to the internet and online resources in the country.

LIME is also sponsoring Antigua and Barbuda's ground-breaking Human Entrepreneurship and Assistive Resource Technology (HEART) development programme. The HEART programme will improve the lives of Antiguan through better access to and training in technology. We are therefore pleased that LIME is also working with us on the HEART project that will improve access to and understanding of technologies for thousands of people."
